

Contact Lens Fitting & Evaluation Fees

--During the fitting, the doctor will determine which contact lens is best for your eyes. Since your eyes may change year to year, it is a necessity to re-evaluate your contact lenses, even if you have worn the same type of lenses for several years and are, once again, refitted for the same lens, to avoid discomfort and/or possible trauma to the eye.

--After your initial fitting, you are required to return for **one** follow up visit so the doctor can verify that the contact lens is the right fit, and that the prescription is working for you. Follow ups must be within 30 days of exam to avoid a refit fee.

****Some cases differ, the doctor will let you know ahead of time****

--There is a mandatory fee to be evaluated for contacts. This fee can range from \$155-\$185 and is determined by the doctor based on the complexity of your prescription and the condition of your eye. **You will be required to pay this fee on the day of the exam.** If you are unable to pay the fee today, you can schedule a time after your exam to come in specifically for the contact lens fitting/evaluation.

--Please note some vision insurance plans do not cover the fitting and evaluation. Therefore, you will be responsible for this payment. We will let you know of this beforehand.

--Your fitting/evaluation fee will cover your initial fitting, any trial contacts the doctor prescribes, and a follow up visit(s).

--Any medical visits are **NOT** covered by this fee.

--Most plans provide coverage for contact lenses in lieu of eyeglasses. What this means, is you can use your insurance for glasses **OR** contacts.
